We will have a focus on Nativity and Christmas themed work in December and begin a new topic in January.

Homework

Homework bags are given out every Monday and are due in on a Friday. This will consist of Literacy tasks such as reading and spelling. Children are also required to work on their common word walls daily. When appropriate, children will also be given Numeracy tasks.

Please ensure that homework is done and returned on time as it supports your child's learning.

Children are required to bring in their book bags every day to allow us to use reading books in class, please.

Numeracy and Mathematics

During Term 2 we are working on addition and subtraction, and will then be moving on to the introduction of multiplication and division.

Literacy

We have begun Stage 2 of our spelling programme and are currently in the final consolidation week before moving on to new phonemes next week.

Children receive a book a week to allow them to practise their reading skills. They have tasks in class to do based on their books, such as skimming and scanning and oral comprehension questions.
