Our topic for Term 3 is 'Me and My Street' Our big questions will be: What does my street and local area look like? & What amenities can I access within my local area?

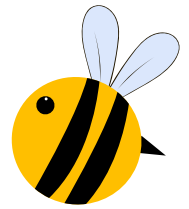
