Homework

Homework bags are given out every Monday and are due in on a Friday. This will consist of Literacy tasks such as reading, spelling and writing sentences. Children are also required to work on their common word/ HFWs walls daily. When appropriate, children will also be given Numeracy tasks.

Please ensure that homework is done and returned on time as it supports your child's learning.

Children are required to bring in their book bags every day to allow us to use reading books in class, please.

Numeracy and Mathematics

During Term 2 we have been working on estimation and rounding, fractions and measure and will then be moving on to the introduction of time.

Literacy

We have started the Monster Phonics programme in Primary 2 which the children are really enjoying! We are learning the phonics and High Frequency Words with resources such as songs, videos, written activities and stories.

Children continue to receive a book a week to allow them to practise their reading and comprehension skills.
