ParentsPortal (P1-7 only)

ParentsPortal is a website and App which will be our main form of communication with P1-7 parents/carers from August 2024. ParentsPortal is used to view and update important documents such as the Annual data check, EV5's used for trip permissions, your child's address and photo permissions. 
Twitter/School website

Google Classroom (P1-7)

Primary 1-7 will use Google Classroom to set homework weekly

Learning Journals (Nursery)

Nursery update Learning Journals weekly with photos and achievements of their children. Learning Journals is personal to each child and will be updated weekly with your child's photos of their experiences. We will also communicate important information including our monthly Sway through Learning Journals.

Online Safety



Online Safety is a hot topic and is an area I would encourage parents to learn more about. Many of our children have phones and as a result they have access to the internet. This is one of the biggest dangers facing our children. The age limit for social media is age 13 and over. If your child is accessing What'sApp, Snapchat, Tik Tok etc. they are very easily exposed to dangerous situations.

Children generally find managing friendships challenging and when they are interacting online with no adult supervision, this can lead to difficulties. If your child has a phone,

- ensure the security settings are at the highest level
 - regularly check the content of their phone

- talk with your child about safe and unsafe behaviours
 - report any activity

Inappropriate interactions on a phone is a police matter and not a school matter. There are some excellent materials to support you in keeping your child safe. More information can be found at

School Improvement Plan 2024-25



Our School Improvement Priorities

Priority 1

Develop high quality learning in science which takes account of sustainability and embeds literacy, numeracy and HWB across the curriculum.

Implement Year 2 of Equality Ambassadors plan

Priority 2

Improve attainment in numeracy through the embedding of HAM at nursery and Maths Recovery at P1-7

Improve attainment in reading by improving reading for pleasure and attaining Reading Schools *accreditation.*

Priority 3

Improve children's development and learning physically, emotionally and intellectually through the implementation of our HWB Framework, further embedding the Rights of the Child throughout the school, Eco Schools accreditation and attaining Attachment Informed, Trauma Sensitive Practice accreditation.
