August 2025 Primary 1 enrolment



Children who are aged 5 between 1st March 2025 and the end of February 2026 are required to be registered for starting school in August 2025, by completing an online registration form which will be available from Monday 6th January. The form can be accessed by pasting the link below into a search engine, or by visiting South Lanarkshire Council's website. All

children should be enrolled with their catchment school in the first instance, even if the child is to be deferred or a placing request is sought.

A catchment checker and information on how to request a deferral or placing request, along with associated forms can be found by following the link or visiting the website.

The catchment school will contact families week beginning 13th January to check the details of the enrolment and the documents provided to support the enrolment.

Please note that the documents accepted are:

Full birth certificate (this can be purchased from the registry office if parents/carers don't have the original)

2 official proofs of residence (preferably no older than 6 months) e.g. bank statement which show the address being in the school catchment area (this must be in the name of the person enrolling the child).

Enrolment will only be completed once these documents have been checked.
